

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE GAS WORKERS UNION - LOCAL 18007 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Gas Workers Union Local 18007's Annual Scholarship Program has been set up for children of current Local 18007 members in good standing ONLY.

In the case of children whose last name may be different than that of the member's, proof may have to be shown that the child applying does in fact reside with the member and is the financial responsibility of that member.

- **Each eligible applicant must submit an application form.**
- **Each eligible applicant must submit a short essay about:** "Interview your family household and describe as a Union household (Local 18007 member) the 3 elements that have impacted you, concerning Wages, Working conditions, and Benefits which will encourage you to continue the same tradition." (500 words or less)

Completed applications with the attached essay must be submitted to the Union office in person or by mail postmarked no later than **August 31, 2017** for the application to be eligible. All applications 'must be notarized' or it will not be accepted.

\$1,000 (One Thousand Dollars) will be awarded, to be used for the 2017/2018 school year, and may be used on tuition or books.

Random Drawing will be held and winner will be announced at the September 2017 Membership Meeting.
